MASTER CLINICAL TRIAL AGREEMENT AMENDMENT 2 FOR RENEWAL

This Master Clinical Trial Agreement Amendment No. 2 (hereinafter the "AMENDMENT No. 2") effective as of 13 August 2020, hereinafter the "Amendment Effective Date", and is by and between UCB BIOSCIENCES, INC. with an address at 8010 Arco Corporate Drive, Raleigh, NC 27617 ("SPONSOR") and the following member institutions of The University of Texas System, ("SYSTEM"), having a place of business at 210 West 7th Street, Austin, TX 78701, as governed by its Board of Regents ("Board"): THE UNIVERSITY OF TEXAS HEALTH SCIENCE CENTER AT HOUSTON, THE UNIVERSITY OF TEXAS HEALTH SCIENCE CENTER AT HOUSTON, THE UNIVERSITY OF TEXAS SOUTHWESTERN MEDICAL BRANCH AT AUSTIN, THE UNIVERSITY OF TEXAS SOUTHWESTERN MEDICAL CENTER, and THE UNIVERSITY OF TEXAS RIO GRANDE VALLEY (hereinafter collectively or individually referred to as "INSTITUTION"), herinafter individually referred to as a "PARTY" and together the "PARTIES".

WHEREAS, the PARTIES have entered into a Master Clinical Trial Agreement, effective 13th day of August 2013, and its Amendment No. 1 dated 14 April 2017 (hereinafter the "**AGREEMENT**");

WHEREAS, the PARTIES desire to extend the term of the Agreement for another seven (7) years beginning with the Amendment Effective Date and wish to amend certain terms of the Agreement and make therefore this Amendment No. 2.

NOW THEREFORE, in consideration of the premises and of the mutual covenants herein, the PARTIES agree that:

- In modification of the Term and Termination Article in the Agreement, the PARTIES mutually agree to
 extend the term of the Agreement for another seven (7) years beginning with the Amendment Effective
 Date and this Agreement shall continue for such seven (7) year term, unless earlier terminated in
 accordance with this Agreement.
- 2. The definition of **ENROLLED SUBJECT** shall be deleted in its entirety and replaced with the following: "STUDY PARTICIPANT shall mean an individual who: (i) meets the criteria for participation and continuing participation in the STUDY, as defined in the PROTOCOL, (ii) excludes a screen failure, and (iii) signs an informed consent form ("ICF") approved by SPONSOR in accordance with this AGREEMENT after being duly informed of the nature, significance, implications, and risks of the STUDY PRODUCT and the nature of the STUDY." In this regard, any references to "ENROLLED SUBJECT" in the AGREEMENT or any WORK ORDER shall be read as references to the "STUDY PARTICIPANT".

- 3. Subsection 2.3 (f) of the AGREEMENT shall be deleted in its entirety.
- 4. New Section 9.5 is added and states:

Notwithstanding the foregoing, INSTITUTION's compliance with Article 9 shall not impede or delay INSTITUTION's compliance with any REGULATORY AUTHORITY inquiry.

5. The last sentence of Section 11.2 is amended as follows:

INSTITUTION agrees that it will not use any contractors or subcontractors in the conduct of any STUDY hereunder <u>unless it obtains UCB's prior written consent</u>.

6. The last sentence of Section 11.4 is amended as follows: INSTITUTION agrees that it will not use any contractors or subcontractors in the conduct of any STUDY hereunder <u>unless it obtains UCB's prior written consent</u>.

7. Section 11.5 has been deleted in its entirety and replacement with the following:

"For the avoidance of doubt, the PATIENT MEDICAL RECORDS shall remain the property of the INSTITUTION. Other than a grant of a limited license to the INSTITUTION and INVESTIGATOR solely to permit them to carry out the STUDY hereunder, and a non-exclusive right to the INSTITUTION to use the STUDY RESULTS and STUDY IP generated by INSTITUTION for its own internal non-commercial educational and research purposes, and to treat patients consistent with applicable standards of medical care, subject to the obligation of Article 7 (Confidentiality and Non-Disclosure), this AGREEMENT does not constitute any grant, option or license under any INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY rights of the SPONSOR.

8. Section 13.2 (a) shall be deleted in its entirety and replaced with the following:

"The terms of the Protocol or any written instruction relative to the administration of the STUDY PRODUCT or DEVICE are not strictly adhered to; notwithstanding the foregoing, deviations from the terms of the Protocol that may arise out of medical necessity to an STUDY PARTICIPANT shall not be deemed to be failure to adhere to the terms of the Protocol, do not constitute negligence, willful misconduct, or grounds for termination of this AGREEMENT or the applicable WORK ORDER, and do not limit or negate the SPONSOR's obligations to indemnify INSTITUTION pursuant to Article 13.1 of this AGREEMENT, provided that (i) the need for such deviation was not caused by INSTITUTION'S and/or INVESTIGATOR'S failure to comply with the Protocol, (ii) such deviation is consistent with prevailing standards of medical care; and (iii) INSTITUTION and/or INVESTIGATOR provided prompt written notice to SPONSOR detailing the deviation."

- 9. Attachment 1 has been deleted in its entirety and replaced with the attachment hereto.
- 10. All other terms of the Agreement remain in full force and effect.
- 11. This AMENDMENT No. 2 shall not be considered accepted, approved, or otherwise effective until UCB MCTA Amendment 2 Renewal The University of Texas System
